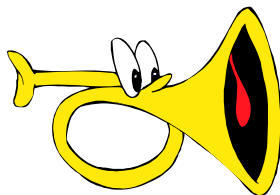
Information Committee's NEW NAME IS THE 4-1-1 Committee

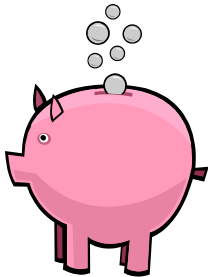
