A tryke was given away to Jeremy Garber a 37 year old Veteran who is married to his wonderful wife Tara. Between them they have 6 children and a granddaughter. He joined the Army National Guard in Nov. 2001 and was deployed to Iraq for 13 months in 2004-2005. His deployment was with a transportation company. Where he spent his time on a gun truck, escorting supply convoys from ports in Kuwait to military camps all over Iraq. The convoys were attacked 37 times , although by the grace of God, there were no deaths or serious injuries. He was awarded the Combat Action badge, Army Commendation medal, and Army Achievement medal for his actions on the gun truck. After returning from deployment and going back to a civilian job as a tree climber, a miscalculation with his safety gear resulted in a fall of about 25 feet. Mr. Garber landed on his back, which left him with incomplete paralysis at the T 10 level. He was in MVH for about 6 weeks. Several months later he moved to Mason, Ohio where he attended Physical Therapy for 20 hours a week for 18 months. During that time he gained the ability to walk on crutches for short distances. He returned to WSU Jan. 2011 to obtain a bachelors degree in psychology, which he will have completed by March. His goal is to complete a graduate program in counseling and work with returning veterans.
