2013 OHIO WOMEN VETERANS CONFERENCE



“I had one of the best weekends of my life as an AMBUC/Greenebuc with two great events,” say Devlynn Tanner. AMBUCS volunteers Sandy Zimmerman, Bill Fulton National Advisory Board-Veteran’s Initiative and Devlynn Tanner attended the 2013 Ohio Women Veterans Conference in Columbus, Ohio. The event was well attended with 750 Ohio Women Veterans and 60 vendors. Jessica Lynch-POW Keynote Speaker held everyone spell bound as she spoke to the group about how she overcame her obstacles and her perseverance that helped her survive her ordeal, rescue and rehabilitation. Greenebucs has given away only one female Veteran bike in the state of Ohio. Several Veterans stopped by to find out more about the Veteran Initiative Program.

The members of the Moose put the trykes as well as the two Veteran bikes together. Bill Fulton from Danville, Illinois represented National AMBUCS-Veteran Initiative Program was on hand to receive the \$2500.00 donation to Greenebucs. Palmer Boyd a veteran with 4 deployments received a specially adaptive tryke due to his 6’7” height. Rodger Blankenship another veteran from Dayton VA Cardiac Rehab. Dept. who is unable to continue walking because of back disc disease can now ride his new bike. Another supporter of Greenebucs the V-Twin Cruisers MC Springfield Ohio Chapter of Patriot Guards presented Palmer with a gas card as he and his family drove from Eaton, Ohio to the Indian Lake Moose.
