

Thursday Started with the National Big Hat Business Meeting, followed by the General Business Session, and then the National Big Hat Lunch and Auction.

The General Business Session gave the attendees an overview of how AMBUCS is doing. Lots of charts and numbers, suffice to say we are doing good. Our membership is growing! 15 New Chapters! We are now up to 165 Chapters nationwide and 3800 members, up from 3600 the previous year. \$196,000 dollars in scholarships to 230 students, 1014 reported Amtrykes, and 573 reported service projects.

As always the Big Hat Lunch and Auction was a lot of fun, with a large number of Auction items selling with all the proceeds going to help fund our mission.


