
September 28th is the Miami Valley Down Syndrome Association Buddy Walk.

Something Good to Eat

Creamy White Chicken Chili

This white chicken chili gets its creaminess, richness, and subtlety tangy flavor from heavy whipping cream and sour cream. Make sure to incorporate the dairy-rich ingredients after the chili is taken off the heat. Otherwise, the mixture will curdle. Add fresh jalapeno slices for a little heat. Tortilla chips will add a welcome crunch.



1 tablespoon olive oil

1 pound skinless, boneless chicken breast halves, cut into

½-inch cubes

1 onion, chopped

2 cloves garlic, chopped

2 (15.5 ounce) cans great Northern beans, rinsed and

drained

1 (14.5 ounce) can chicken broth

2 (4 ounce) cans chopped green chiles

1 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cumin

1 teaspoon dried oregano

½ teaspoon ground black pepper

1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper

1 cup sour cream

½ cup heavy whipping cream



Directions

Gather ingredients.

Heat olive oil in a large saucepan over medium heat.

Add chicken, onion, and garlic; cook and stir until chicken is no longer pink in the center and juices run clear, 10 to 15 minutes.

Stir in beans, chicken broth, green chiles, salt, cumin, oregano, black pepper, and cayenne pepper; bring to a boil.

Reduce heat and simmer until flavors have blended, about 30 minutes. Remove chili from heat; stir in sour cream and whipping cream until incorporated.

Serve hot and enjoy!
